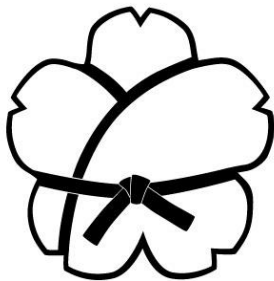




28th International Thuringia Cup Judo for female cadets (u18) and juniors (u21) March 23rd, 2019

- Promoter: Thuringia Judo Federation (member of the **German Judo Federation**)
- Venue: Sports center of Bad Blankenburg ;
Wirbacher Straße 10, 07422 Bad Blankenburg
- Eligibility: Cadets under 18: girls born in 2002-2004
Juniors under 21: girls born in 1999-2002
- Categories: U18 -40kg, -44kg, -48kg, -52kg, -57kg, -63kg, -70kg, +70kg,
U21 -44kg, -48kg, -52kg, -57kg, -63kg, -70kg, -78kg, +78kg
- System: IJF-System (KO-System with double repechage, modification possible)
Only blue and white judogi are allowed.
- Schedule:**
Friday, March 22nd, 2019
15.30 h - 19.30 h official check-in and weighing for all categories
Weighing until 20.00h (latest)
Saturday, March 23rd, 2019
08.15 h opening ceremony
08.30 h start of contests
- Registration/Accommodation: You have to register the number of Judoka until **March 12th, 2019** with the full name, the date of birth and the weight category. The maximum of competitors will be 600. Accreditation after arrival will be at the sports center. Organisation of at least 2 overnight stays are possible depending on capacity. Locations of accommodations are not limited to Bad Blankenburg! Please make sure you can organize your transport individually!
- Registration fee: The registration fee will be **30 EURO per registered Judoka**.
The registration fee after March 12th, 2019 will be 60 EURO.
The fee has to be paid with the registration by transfer to the bank account. **There is no refund!!**
- Referees: Will be organised by the promoter. However, all international Judo-Clubs or Associations may bring (at their own expenses) licensed referees of international or high national level. If you do so, please, inform us in advance.
