5. Participation Rules

Each participant is responsible to follow:

• The rules to enter the host country and the local government health measures.

Any participant is eligible to inscribe in the competition provided he/she is:

- Not under a disciplinary suspension.
- Not under suspension for anti-doping rule violation.
- Not carrying any communicable diseases that may risk other delegates' health.

In addition to the above athletes must:

- Not be under medical suspension.
- Be healthy and fit for competition.
- Born in 1993 (30 years as of December 31, 2023) or before.
- Hold a National Federation's membership currently affiliated to the IJF.
- Hold minimum 1st Kyu
- Athletes must not have represented a National Team in a competition at international senior level at any time in the twelve months period before the start date of this Japan Veteran International Judo Championships.
- Have sufficient technical knowledge (know the terminology and can execute all the techniques in the IJF SOR Appendix H) and understand fully the IJF sport and refereeing rules.

9. Judogi and back number

Athletes must compete waring a white judogi with back number (name and country). Judogi size must compliant with the IJF rules. Judogi control with Sokuteiki will be conducted.

The Female athletes must wear a white plain t-shirt.

Long hair has to be bounded with an elastic band. Wearing Make-up or accessories is prohibited. The nails have to be cut short.

10. Competition Rules

Kata

Competition will be carried out according to the IJF Kata regulation.

- Nage no Kata
- Katame no Kata
- Kime no Kata
- Ju no Kata
- Kodokan Goshinjutsu
- Itsutsu no Kata
- Koshiki no Kata

Athletes can compete only one of above kata. The organizer will provide weapons for Kime no Kata and Kodokan Goshinjutsu.

Individual

The winner will be decided by Waza-ari or above.

If there is no difference score between 2 athletes at the end of the match, an athlete with less Shido will become winner. If there is no difference score and Shido, the winner will be decided by flag decision.

11. Accommodation and Transportation

Participants may arrange their accommodation and transportation on their own.

12. Insurance

They must have insurance either held personally in the form of specific insurance cover or travel cover (which does not exclude participating in judo competition) or as part of their National Federation insurance arrangements. Neither Organizing office nor All Japan Judo Federation will not be responsible of any claims of illness, Injury and death, of any participants/officials.

13. Anti-doping control

The Organizer has strong anti-doping policy, but there will be no anti-doping control at this Championships.

14. <u>Other</u>

- All medalists must attend the medal ceremony with full white Judogi.
- Since the competition time might be changed due to competitions' progress, all athletes should be ready for competition at least 45 minutes prior to the estimated start time.
